THE ATLANTIS PROGRAM

Atlantis Program Joint Curriculum Agreement

for

Students whose home schools are Marshall University, the University of Debrecen Centre of Arts, Humanities and Sciences and the Warsaw School of Social Psychology

This agreement articulates the bachelor's degree requirements in psychology for students within the Atlantis exchange program through Marshall University (MU), the University of Debrecen, Centre of Arts, Humanities and Sciences (UD CAHS), and the Warsaw School of Social Psychology (WSSP) in order to allow the awarding of double/dual BA degrees in psychology.

This agreement is based upon review of the unique requirements for the bachelor's degrees at the University of Debrecen, Centre of Arts, Humanities and Sciences and at Marshall University, as well as upon the applicable course offerings at the Warsaw School of Social Psychology.

The conditions articulated below apply only to the three universities listed above, and only to psychology majors within the Atlantis Program. One (1) credit earned at MU is equivalent to two (2) Hungarian Units (HU) or two (2) ECTS. One (1) HU or one (1) ECTS equals one-half (.5) semester credit hours. One (1) HU = one (1) ECTS.

I. In order for students whose home schools are the University of Debrecen, Centre of Arts, Humanities and Sciences and the Warsaw School of Social Psychology to earn the B.A. in psychology at Marshall University, they will meet the Marshall University requirements for the BA in psychology, with the following provisos:

- UD students must earn a BA in psychology from UD CAHS.
- WSSP students must earn at least 33 semester credit hours (or equivalent in HU and/or ECTS) in psychology at any of the partner institutions.
- Students must complete the Atlantis exchange program as detailed in the General Agreement and in the Student Exchange Agreement.

- The MU composition course requirements may be met by completion of three of the UD CAHS research courses/projects at UD CAHS or by the Basic and Advanced Academic Writing courses at WSSP.
- The MU foreign language requirement may be met by satisfactory completion of the Atlantis program.
- The MU requirement for a "minor" may be met by completion of any 24 HU credits earned at UD CAHS, or 24 ECTS credits at WSSP.
- The MU multicultural requirement may be met by successful completion of the Atlantis Program.
- The MU International requirement may be met by successful completion of the Atlantis Program.
- The MU Writing Intensive requirement may be met by completion of a thesis at either UD CAHS or WSSP.

II. In order for students whose home school is the Warsaw School of Social Psychology to earn the B.A. in psychology at the University of Debrecen, Centre of Arts, Humanities and Sciences the following requirements must be met:

- WSSP students must earn the BA degree in psychology from MU.
- WSSP students must complete at least 24-30 HU at the UD CAHS, including 18-30 HU in the field of Psychology.
- WSSP students must earn at least 30 semester hours at Marshall University, including 15 semester hours in the field of Psychology.
- WSSP students must complete the Atlantis exchange program as detailed in the General Agreement and in the Student Exchange Agreement.

III. In order for students whose home school is Marshall University to earn the B.A. in Psychology at the University of Debrecen, Centre of Arts, Humanities and Sciences the following requirements must be met:

- MU students must earn the BA degree in psychology from MU.
- MU students must complete at least 24-30 ECTS at the Warsaw School of Social Psychology, including 18-30 ECTS in the field of Psychology.
- MU students must complete at least 24-30 HU at the UD CAHS, including 18-30 HU in the field of Psychology.
- The MU foreign language requirement may be met by satisfactory completion of the Atlantis Program.
- The MU International requirement may be met by successful completion of the Atlantis program.
- MU students must complete the Atlantis exchange program as detailed in the General Agreement and in the Student Exchange Agreement.

By our signatures below we agree to the above requirements to allow the awarding of double/dual BA degrees in psychology awarded by MU and UD CAHS.
